MOVE OVER LAW

The "Move Over Law," TCA 55-8-132, which passed in 2006, requires motorists to move over into the adjacent lane of traffic, when safe to do so, or alternatively to slow down for emergency vehicles.

YIELDING FOR ..

In 2011, the law was expanded to include utility service equipment to the list of vehicles for which motorists are required to either slow down or move over.

PENALTY

The penalty for violating the "Move Over Law" in Tennessee is a maximum fine of up to \$500 and possibly up to 30 days in jail.
